

Upgrade Brother QL-1050 and QL-1060N Print Driver

Purpose

To be able to use the new label **DK-22246** clients need to upgrade the print drivers.

Instructions

Search for the correct printer -

Steps below are more or less identical on both QL-1050 and QL-1060N

1. If you have QL-1060N, download the driver from
 - <https://support.brother.com/g/b/downloadtop.aspx?c=gb&lang=en&prod=ql1060neuk> and select your Operating System. or
 - <https://sstmvc.com/clientsetup/ql1060.exe>
 - for clients running Windows 10 x64

2. Unpack to your preferred location.
3. Disconnect the Printer from your Computer
4. Go to the location you have unpacked the files and run D_SETUP, preferable run as administrator.
5. You will be notified to disconnect the printer and if you have done so click Start.

Brother QL-1060N Driver will be installed.

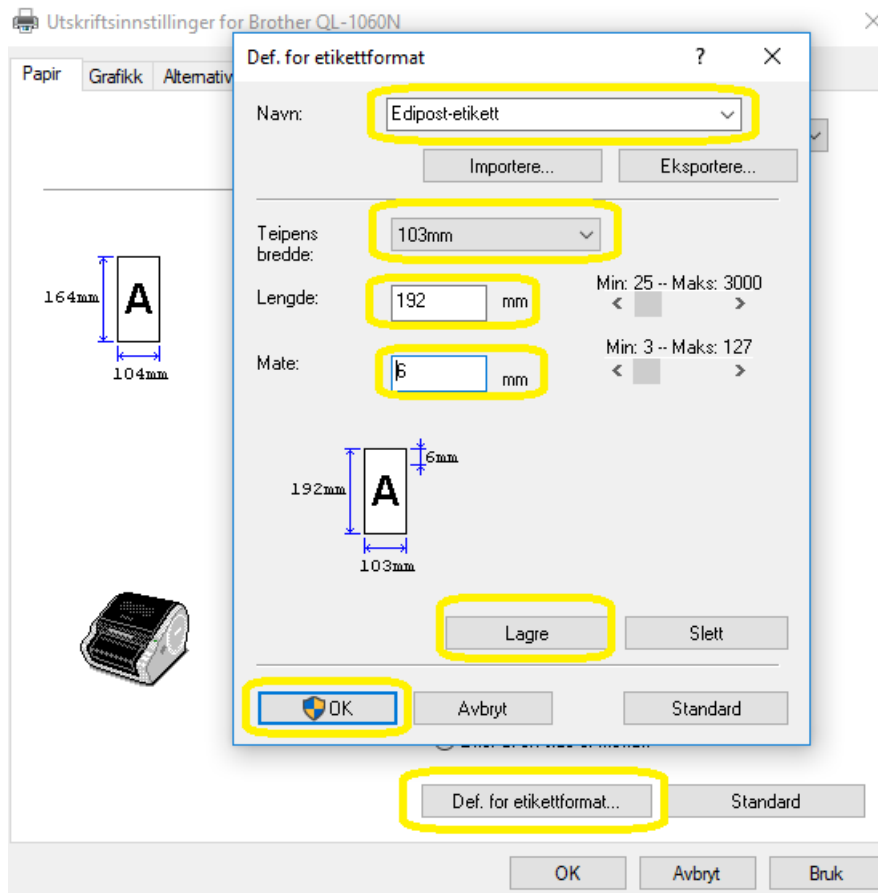
7. You will then be requested to connect the printer and then turn it on. Do so.
8. If requested to restart your computer Click **OK** in order to enable the new driver.



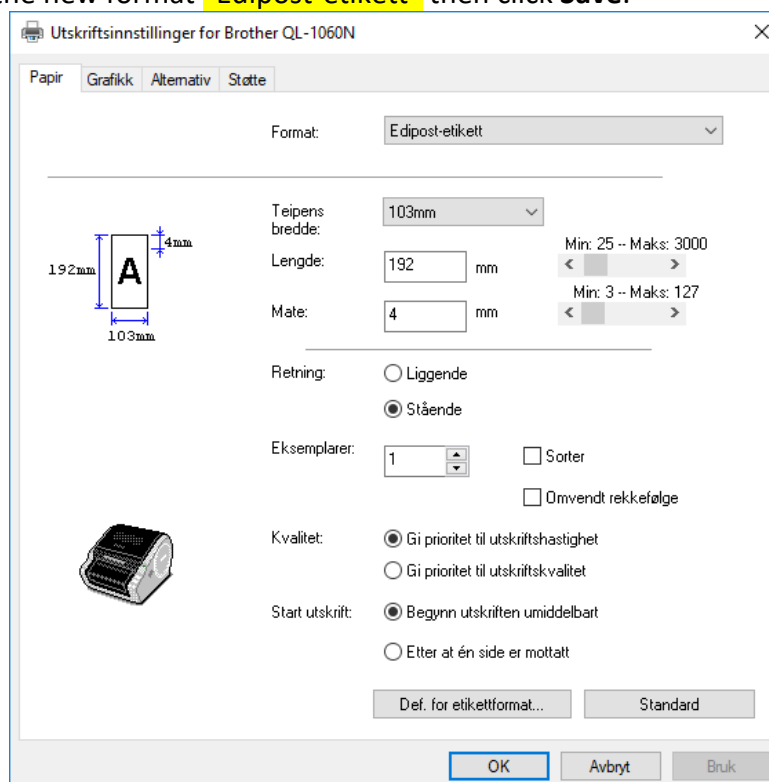
9. When the computer is restarted go to control panel and open **Devices and Printers**
10. Right click QL-1060N printer and select **Printer properties**.
11. Click **Advanced Tab** then, **Printing Defaults** button. If the button is greyed out you will need to login the system with an account with administrator privileges.



12. On the Brother QL-1060N properties, make sure **"Edipost-etikett (103x192mm)"** is selected on the Format dropdown and then Click on **Label format definitions** button below. If this format is not available on the drop down list, do as follow: Click on 'Def for Etikettformat', to make a new one. Follow the yellow fields below, from top to down.



13. Choose the new format **"Edipost-etikett"** then click **Save**.

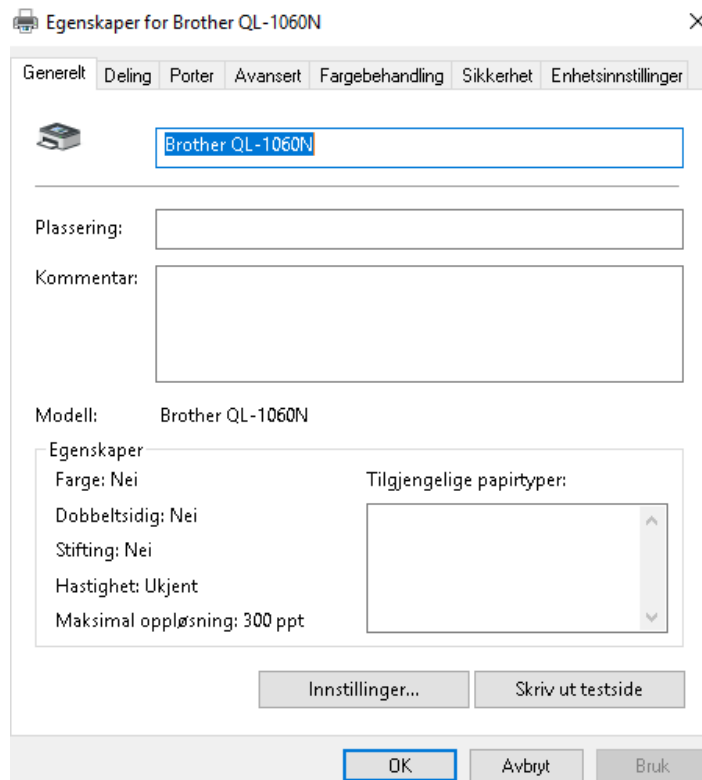


14. Click **OK**, if user access list prompts you to allow changes click **Yes**.

15. Make sure that format **Edipost-etikett (103x192mm)** is selected and the width is set to **103mm**.

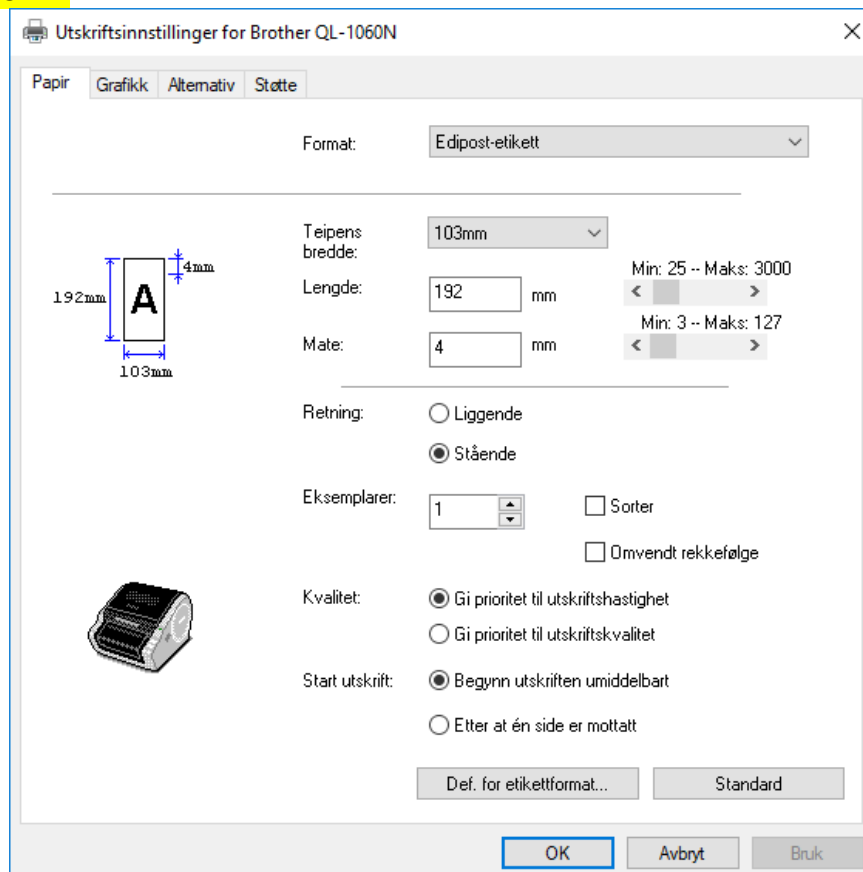
16. Click **OK**
